## b) <u>Paper</u>

Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, office waste paper, but <u>no</u> folders with metal or plastic parts, <u>no</u> laminated paper.

# Deposit bundled paper in the garage, <u>small</u> quantities that are unsuitable for bundling may be put in the labelled basket.

## c) Compostable waste

E.g. garden waste, flowers, salad leaves, potato peel, uncooked vegetable, but <u>no</u> leftover food.

Deposit in the two green bins behind the church (by the parking places)

### d) General household waste

Please bring enough rubbish bags to dispose of all your waste.

Please take the bags home with you or you can pay extra and deposit them in the church's rubbish skip on the pavement. Please pay for every garbage bag you place in the skip – there is a tin on the kitchen window sill.
