The Art of Faith

Since the dawn of civilization, humanity has sought to express spiritual realities through the use of art. A visit to a cathedral, a sculpture in a park or a painting in a museum all have the power to speak about truths that are sometimes ineffable. From the primitive scratchings in the catacombs, to the abstract stained glass in places like Cologne, Christians have seen art as something to bolster the spirit or instruct the faithful.

At this year's Fall Weekend, we will examine the intersection between art and faith. We will analyze works of art: what they have to say to us and how they say it. And we will create works of art ourselves. In the end, the hope is that we will see how art can be a companion on our spiritual pilgrimage.

A little bit about Revd Dan:

Revd Dan was born and raised in Oklahoma in the United States. He was ordained in the Episcopal Church in 2007 and has been serving at St. Andrew's, Zurich since October 2008. Before coming to Switzerland, he served as a youth minister, deacon and priest at congregations in Oklahoma, Missouri, Paris, France and Los Angeles, California. At university Revd Dan studied Philosophy,

Religion and Art History before gaining a Master's of Divinity at the Claremont School of Theology.
